"Proof That the Word Became Flesh" John 1:14-18 January 25, 2015

"And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.

(John bore witness about him, and cried out, "This was he of whom I said, 'He who comes after me ranks before me, because he was before me.")

For from his fullness we have all received, grace upon grace.

For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.

No one has ever seen God; the only God, who is at the Father's side, he has made him known."

John 1:14-18 (ESV)

Question: Who is the Word? Answer: Jesus

Definition of "incarnation": God incorporated in flesh

Some people would read or hear John say that God became flesh and dwelt among us and will say, "Prove it." John says, "Ok, I will give you **four proofs**."

Proof #1: We beheld His glory. (v.14)

Proof #2: John the Baptist bore witness that Jesus was God in the flesh. (v.15)

Proof #3: We can testify of the fullness of grace and truth given to us by Jesus Christ. (v. 16.17)

Proof #4: If you want to see God clearly, just look at Jesus. (v.18)
