"Yes, You Will Be Tested on This" John 5:17-47 May 17, 2015

Jesus is literally the Son of God, "his own Father." (v.17)

So Jesus is <u>God</u> the <u>Son</u> of God, and a <u>Man.</u> (v. 18)

So, how can you understand this difficult concept? Faith (v.18)

Jesus and God (Father) are in perfect <u>unity.</u> (v. 19-23)

Jesus is equal with God, his Father. (v. 19-23)

The task of judgment has been assigned to <u>Jesus</u>. (V.19-23)

Resurrection means to bring back to life. (V.24-29)

Resurrection of <u>Death</u>

Four Witnesses for Jesus (v. 30-47) 1. <u>John the Baptist</u> (Malachi 4:5-6; Matthew 11:13-14)

- 2. the works of Jesus
- 3. the Scriptures

There are over <u>300</u> references in the Old Testament fulfilled by Jesus. 700BC names Bethlehem the <u>birth city.</u> (Micah 5:2)

> David 1000BC said his <u>hands and feet</u> would be pierced. (Psalm 22:16-18)

Moses wrote in 1450BC that Messiah would crush Satan's head. (Genesis 3:15)
