The backdrop of verse 12:

The theological significance of verse 12:

Throughout the Bible "Light" is used to symbolize God.

- 1. Psalm 27:1
- 2. Psalm 36:9
- 3. Acts 9:3
- 4. 1 John 1:5

The practical significance of verse 12:

- A. Light <u>alerts</u> us to <u>dangers</u>
- B. Light <u>trumps</u> darkness.
- C. Light denotes understanding.
- D. Light is necessary for life and growth.

What does it mean to follow Christ? (five meanings of the Greek word follow)

- 1. It's used of a soldier who follows his captain.
- 2. It's used of a <u>slave</u> accompanying his <u>master</u>.
- 3. It's used in the sense of accepting or applying the wisdom of a wise counselor.
- 4. It means to obey the laws of government or the standards that are set up.
- 5. It's used of a <u>student</u> following his <u>teacher's</u> arguments.

Summary of what it means to follow Christ: A true follower of Jesus Christ is someone who surrenders their <u>heart.</u> <u>body</u> and <u>soul</u> to Christ. It's <u>total</u> and <u>complete</u> surrender!

- IV. Two promises for those who follow Christ:
  - A. They will escape darkness.
  - B. They will have the <u>light of life</u>.

Three reasons why His personal witness is valid:

- 1. I know where I came from and where I am going.
- 2. You judge according to the flesh I judge no one. (v.15)
- 3. My <u>judgment</u> is <u>true</u> for I am <u>not</u> alone. (v.16)
