The three main characters in the letter:

Character #1: <u>The Apostle Paul</u>

- 1. the mediator
- 2. the arbitrator
- 3. the peacemaker
- 4. the writer of the letter

Paul is offering to atone for the wrongs of Onesimus.

Character #2: <u>Onesimus</u>

- 1. A thief and runaway slave
- 2. Gave his heart to Christ under Paul's leadership
- 3. He's on his way back home to Philemon whom he violated.
- 4. He must ask forgiveness regardless of what Philemon says or does.
- 5. He must once again become a slave to Philemon.

Character #3: Philemon

- A wealthy man who also became a Christian under Paul's leadership.
- 2. He allows a church to meet in his home.
- 3. He's a good and decent man. He's well known for loving others.

Philemon's Challenge:

- 1. <u>Throw away</u> the scorebook.
- 2. <u>Forgive</u> Onesimus
- 3. <u>Receive him back not as a slave but as a brother</u>
