Saved, Safe & Secure John 10:19-42 May 15, 2016

Three critical statements:

- 1. The shepherd is responsible for the <u>salvation</u> of the sheep.
- 2. The shepherd is responsible for the <u>safety</u> of the sheep.
- 3. The shepherd is responsible for the <u>security</u> of the sheep.
- I. Are you a saved sheep?

Three-fold test:

- 1. Do you listen to the shepherd? (v.27a)
- Are you <u>known</u> by the shepherd? (v.27b)
 Question: How do you know if Jesus know you? (John 10:14)
 You know that Jesus knows you <u>if you know Him.</u>
- 3. Do you <u>follow</u> the shepherd? (v.27c)
- II. Are you a safe sheep?
 - Note: "Your eternal security is not based on what <u>you do for God</u>; it depends on <u>what God has done for you.</u>
 - 1. Eternal life is a <u>gift</u> (v.28a)
 - 2. Eternal life is something given. (v.28a)
 - 3. Jesus gives <u>eternal life.</u> (v.28a)

III. Are you a secure sheep?

- 1. You are in a <u>double grip.</u> (v.28)
- 2. You are God the Father's gift to Jesus. (v.29a)
